

Frequently Asked Questions about School Uniforms

1. Who is the school's preferred vendor? **Land's End, Inc**
2. Is there a local support vendor if someone has a problem with fittings or any other unforeseen circumstances? **Yes. That vendor is Bahama Joe's, which is located in the Medical Arts Center in Savannah. However, they do not carry the Land's End brand. They use different manufacturers and have limited choices for SCDS.**
3. Is there a contact person that can help with uniform questions? **Yes. Connie Reeves, manager of the Hornet Shop is available to answer uniform questions for the three schools. However, you may also contact the school principals for questions.**
4. Why do we use Bahama Joe's as a back-up uniform supplier? **Due to various circumstances that are sometimes unplanned, such as sizing, or the need of a uniform quickly, a local supplier has been established. This will offer another choice for parents and ease stress.**
5. Is there a difference in the colors or patterns of the plaid skirts? **Yes, there is a difference between the plaids. SCDS accepts both versions, as well as the Sue Mills brand skirts, as long as they are in suitable condition and fit properly.**
6. Can the Sue Mills brand items still be worn? **Yes. Items from Sue Mills that are in good condition may be worn.**
7. Are there different guidelines between the three schools? **Yes. There are some variations, and students must follow those guidelines.**
8. When ordering uniforms from Land's End, what are the preferred school numbers? **The Lower and Middle School preferred number is 900138850. The Upper School preferred number is 900132580.**
9. Can Land's End items be returned or exchanged and is there a cost for shipping? **Land's End does accept returns and**

exchanges, even if the item has been monogrammed. You can contact the Land's End customer service department for assistance, or return the items at no charge at the local Sear's store.
